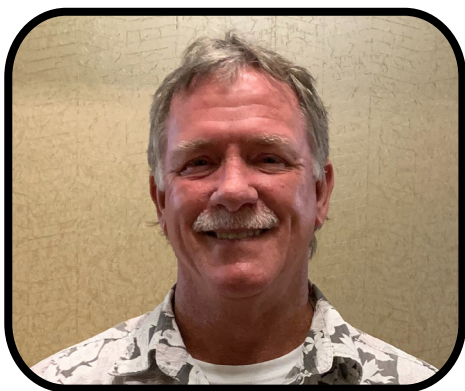
Janice Preciado
